

Penn Colonial Swim Club - Rules and Regulations

The **PENN COLONIAL SWIM CLUB, INC.** shall not be responsible for any accident, injury, theft, or for so-called loss of damage to personal property on the club premise.

Statement of Policy and Procedures

1. The following rules and regulations have been established for the protection and safety of all members and their guests.
2. Parents/Guardians are to instruct their children to observe and obey all of the rules and to follow the instructions of management and Life Guards.
3. The Pool Manager, Assistant Manager (s) and Life Guards will enforce all rules and regulations of the Penn Colonial Swim Club, Inc.
4. The Pool Manager/Assistant Manager (s) will make determinations of any activities or items not covered in the rules and regulations. Appeals to decisions made by the Pool Manager will be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors.
5. Any willful violation of these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for the immediate suspension of pool privileges for the offending member or guest, without refund of any daily entrance fees, though the next full day the pool is in operation.
6. A conference between parent and manager is required before a member under the age of (18) may be readmitted after having been suspended. A member (18) and over will meet with the manager before being readmitted. Successive violations may be considered sufficient cause of cancellation of membership.

Hours of Operation

1. Hours of operation will be determined and posted at the facility each season by the Pool Board. Exceptions may be made due to inclement weather, maintenance or emergencies at the discretion of the Pool Manager, Assistant Manager(s) or the Board of Directors
2. All members shall enter the pool facilities through the bathhouse; with the exception of strollers, wheelchairs and walkers which can enter via the gate.
3. All vehicles shall be properly parked in the lot provided for this purpose. Handicapped parking is available with display of the appropriate motor vehicle Handicapped placard.

Membership Cards

1. Membership cards will be distribute at the front desk at the beginning of each season and will not be mailed. Cards must be shown to gain admittance to the pool each visit.
2. Cards are not transferable.
3. Membership cards for each individual member must be presented at the front desk for admittance to the pool.
4. Cards are reusable. Once cards are issued they are the responsibility of the member.
5. The lost or stolen card replacement fee is \$10 per card.
6. All members under the age of (12) must be accompanied by a member of least (16) years of age.

Guests

1. The management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone. Limitations may be placed on the number of guests who may accompany members to the pool on any given occasion.
2. Guests are the responsibility of the accompanying member and must abide by all pool rules and Regulations.
3. Guests under the age of (12) must be accompanied by a member of at least (16) years of age.
4. Guests fees will be determined each season by the Pool Board.
5. Each guest my only come five (5) times per year.

Health and Safety - Rules and Guidelines

1. Only authorized personnel are permitted in the lifeguard chairs.
2. In the event of an accident and/or injury, report it immediately to the life guard.
3. Basic first aid will be provided by the Manager, Assistant Manager(s) and life guards.
4. The management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, coughs, colds, inflamed eyes, athlete's foot, infectious disorders and /or communicable diseases or persons wearing bandages.
5. No foul or inappropriate language deemed offensive by the general public will be tolerated.
6. Children not fully toilet trained must wear approved pool diapers.
7. Swimmers having long hair must have it properly tied back/secured.
8. No glass containers permitted inside the pool.
9. No children over the age of five (5) are permitted in the baby pool
10. No child wearing a flotation device can be unaccompanied in the main pool. A parent or

guardian must be in the water and within arm's reach at all times.

11. No goggles or flotation devices can be worn on the dive at any time.
